Framed box depicting twelve figures from the Italian Renaissance in the form of small plaster medallions. Mounted on a blue background within a gilded wooden frame from the Charles X period. Italian work, circa 1830-40. Good condition, slight wear to the frame's gilding. Among the figures depicted: Pope Paul II, Leo X, and artists such as Palestrina, Brunelleschi, Ghiberti, etc. Some are signed by Cerbara, others by Girometti. Giuseppe Girometti (1780-1851) was a famous 19th-century Italian sculptor, medalist, and engraver on precious stones. Born in Rome, he is best known for his neoclassical cameos carved from precious stones such as sardonyx and onyx. Niccolò Cerbara (1796-1869): A highly renowned medalist.
