Description

A beautiful carved and gilded wooden mirror from the Louis XV period. This model features small, closed side panels and a tall, curved, sinuous crossbar. The floral decoration consists entirely of curves and counter-curves. High-relief carving--almost in the round--of roses on their stems and foliage. Beautiful openwork pediment, decorated with a large basket of roses, framed by two Cs. All mirrors feature mercury-coated glass in fine condition. High-quality parquet backing. Probably a Provençal piece from the second half of the 18th century. Particularly detailed carving with pronounced relief. Vine tendrils are the usual motif; roses are rare. Very good proportions
