Exceptional Aubusson tapestry - Jean Lurçat - "Poisson" - Atelier Simone André Rare wool Aubusson tapestry, woven from an original design by Jean Lurçat (1892-1966), a leading figure in the revival of French tapestry in the 20th century. Based in Aubusson from 1939 onward, Lurçat revolutionized the art of weaving by developing a powerful and instantly recognizable decorative style, now sought after by collectors around the world. This work, titled "Poisson," was produced by the Ateliers Simone André in Felletin, a workshop renowned for the quality of its weaves based on designs by Aubusson's greatest cartoonists. The design, of remarkable intensity, features stylized fish in vibrant colors set against a deep black background, within a vegetal and cosmic universe.
