This exquisite ring, crafted from high-quality yellow gold, dates from before 1837 and captivates with its richly detailed Georgian craftsmanship and the expressive design characteristic of that era. A dazzling natural diamond, cut in the old-world style and carefully set in a dark-colored flower-shaped setting, lends this ring a mysterious charm. Georgian motif depicting a stylized pansy = "Pansy" motif. Thought, remembrance, or "I'm thinking of you." This piece is engraved and originates from Great Britain. A rare collector's item. Its value is further enhanced by the complete inscription and date, which provide documented historical provenance. Original Georgian mourning ring from England: Inscription: Captain. Eduard Harriman or similar The Latin abbreviation means "obiit"
