Description

A very beautiful and rare depiction of the Eiffel Tower as seen from the Trocadéro Esplanade, featuring the Pont d'Iéna. Signed "Ch Pollaci" in the lower left corner. Charles Pollaci was a figurative painter and lithographer born in Nice on October 19, 1907, and died in Quetteville on June 29, 1988. He lived in a small house in Houilles and was affiliated with the École de Pontoise--where he was considered the leading figure[4]--until the late 1960s, after which he settled in Honfleur. He died in 1988 in Honfleur (a commemorative plaque now hangs on the house where he lived). His works are on display in numerous museums, including the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris. They are also on display at museums in Pontoise, Sceaux, and L'Isle-Adam, among others. He participated in

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numerous art fairs and exhibitions in France and abroad, and the famous automobile manufacturer Henry Ford was one of his clients. Dimensions without its frame 46 par 55 cm.
