Description

For sale: a magnificent, rare pendant made of solid silver (925), set with rose-cut diamonds. Handcrafted in England during the late Victorian era or the Historicist period (1880-1890). It bears two barely legible hallmarks. This piece features masterful gold lacework and openwork filigree, with symmetrical floral and tendril motifs. At the center is a hand-cut diamond rose, set within a raised crown-shaped setting. The surrounding petals are adorned with other vintage accent stones. A timeless piece of jewelry that is perfectly wearable. The pendant weighs 11.73 grams. It measures approximately 6.00 cm in height (including the eyelet) and 3.7 cm in width. In very fine vintage condition, consistent with its age, featuring an authentic patina.
