Description

Porcelain plate from the Compagnie des Indes with a Western-style grisaille decoration: "The Crucifixion of Christ." Circa 1745, 18th century. This is one of a series of designs depicting the life of Christ. A large crowd surrounds the Virgin Mary, Saint John, and the crucified Christ, crowned with thorns, flanked by the two thieves who are also crucified. In the foreground, a soldier hurls insults at Christ, while others, crouched on the ground, are gambling for the garments of the crucified man.
