Bohemian crystalware was famous in the 19th century, rivaling Baccarat in craftsmanship, and supplying imperial courts as well as serving as a source of precious souvenirs for spa guests. This glass, with its display saucer, is one of those small, high-quality items that people could bring home. Crafted from double-layered colored crystal, it is engraved with decorative motifs and landscapes reminiscent of the places visited, and personalized with initials in Gothic script--in keeping with the fashion of the time, of course. Emblematic of this style, this garnet-red creates striking contrasts. Both pieces are a matching set and in perfect condition
