Large Nepalese knife known as a kukuri ((kukri, khukri))--military-style--Nepal, late 19th century to first half of the 20th centuryMilitary-style kukuri issued to Gurkha troops. Wooden handle. Wide, single-edged blade. Wood and leather sheath with a steel ferrule. The rear pocket, which held the two small knives (now missing) and the fire-starting kit, is heavily frayed. Length: 43 cmLength without sheath: 40 cmBlade length: 29 cmWeight: 524 gWeight without sheath: 390 g
