



Victorian 7.50 Cts Diamond Rivière Necklace In Gold And Silver

Description

An 18K rose and yellow gold and silver "Rivière" necklace (hallmark: eagle's head) consisting of a double chain holding a row of diamonds, which in turn supports three diamond-set pendants. Barrel clasp adorned with floral motifs. The necklace is adorned with old-cut and transitional-cut diamonds with an estimated total weight of approximately 7.50 carats. Estimated diamond color: H to I; estimated clarity: VS to SI. 19th-century French craftsmanship. Some diamonds have likely been replaced recently. Gross weight: 22.62 g. Pendant height: 3.00 cm. Chain length: 39.50 cm. Condition: very slight micro-scratches and oxidation on the gold and silver parts, cloudiness and a few chips on the diamonds, and slight wear on the setting; see photos.
