Authentic 19th-century medical scarifier made of brass, preserved in its original case. This surgical instrument was used by physicians for bloodletting (phlebotomy) as well as for scarified cupping. Its spring-loaded mechanism simultaneously activates several blades to make small, superficial incisions before applying a cupping cup. Features: Made of solid brass. Depth adjustment via a knurled wheel. Functional spring mechanism. Original black-painted case with a red interior. Two small star-shaped hallmarks; no visible manufacturer's name. A beautiful antique medical instrument dating from approximately 1830-1880, intended for collectors of scientific and medical instruments, museums, or cabinets of curiosities. Condition : In good condition with a beautiful original patina and normal signs of use.
