A beautiful portrait by the French painter and sculptor Pierre Bonnaud (b. 1865, Lyon - d. 1930). He studied at the École des Beaux-Arts in Lyon with Jean-Baptiste Poncey beginning in 1883; later, he attended the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris under Jean-Paul Laurens, Gustave Moreau, Léon Bonnat, and Léon Gérôme.--He began his career by creating drawings for fashion magazines. He painted portraits, historical paintings, and genre scenes depicting life in Paris (Bohemians, Chansonnettes).
