The top and bottom edges, crafted in finely engraved 18-karat gold, create an elegant contrast with the silver's natural dark patina. The central section is highlighted by large faceted beryls, with a total weight of approximately 40.00 carats. The stones are surrounded by numerous cabochon garnets, totaling approximately 20.00 carats, characterized by intense shades of red and purple. The generous proportions, the substantial weight of the gemstones, and the richness of the craftsmanship make this bracelet a refined
