Description

It is definitely the colors and composition--its patterns--that allow us to determine a piece's geographical origin. The same goes for its dating. Here, there's not the slightest doubt; the piece is documented. It is indeed an antique piece from Mut, which was a small village at the time, located in the Taurus Mountains in southeastern Anatolia. Notice the flamboyant pattern inside each diamond-shaped medallion; the Turks call it "lion's mane." It is actually a symbol evoking protection, and it is complemented by two wolf's muzzles on either side. The colors--as I mentioned earlier--are exclusively natural and plant-based. The palette centers on a brick-ochre background accented with orange and straw yellow. The contrasts are created by ecru patterns. The harmony is subtle and elegant. These are the
