Description

A luminous landscape of the South of France, perhaps in the Var region, depicting the entrance to a property--likely a farm, possibly a vineyard, judging by the foreground of the painting, which appears to show grapevines. Auguste PELABON (1863-1932) was born in Toulon. A painter of landscapes, seascapes, portraits, and still lifes, he was a member of the Société des artistes français. He studied under Bouguereau, Tony Robert-Fleury, and Letuaire, and lived at 10 rue de la Gaîté and at various addresses in Toulon: 4 rue Saint-Cyprien and 87 cours Lafayette. From 1886 to 1891, he exhibited portraits and landscapes of the Var region around Toulon at the Salon des Artistes Français.
