Description

An elegant Louis XV mirror, dating from the late 19th century in France, crafted from richly veined burl veneer and framed by an elegant, festooned Rococo frame. The mirror features a finely carved rocaille shell motif--an iconic element of the Rococo style--that adds dynamism and adorns its silhouette. The warm, natural patina of the burl veneer highlights the depth and variation of the wood grain, giving the piece its unique character. Slight signs of age are present, characteristic of an authentic antique French mirror dating from around 1880. This Louis XV-style mirror is ideal for collectors and interior designers seeking a neo-Rococo touch imbued with authentic period charm. It will look perfect above a console table, in an entryway, or as a centerpiece in a refined interior.
