An elegant set of four armchairs in solid cherry wood, in the Directoire style, made in France around the mid-20th century. These armchairs captivate with their understated and balanced lines, inspired by the neoclassical repertoire. The backs are adorned with an elegant openwork motif in the shape of a stylized lyre, enhanced by a decoration of finely carved leaves. The fluted legs, curved armrests, and the quality of the joinery attest to particularly meticulous cabinetmaking. The seats, fully straw-tufted in the traditional manner, are in good condition and form a beautiful, cohesive ensemble. The cherry wood features a warm honey-colored patina that highlights its fine grain and the wood's beautiful quality. One armchair shows a discreet, earlier restoration on a carved element of the backrest,
