### Description

The work depicts a river landscape at dusk: poplars and trees mirrored in the still water, a house nestled on the bank, beneath a sky glowing with pink and golden tones. A sensitive, atmospheric composition with rich, vibrant handling, characteristic of the artist's

Post-Impressionist manner -- a landscape subject rarer in his output, which is best known for opera and ballet scenes. Dimensions : 38,5 × 46 cm Jean-Louis-Marcel Cosson (Bordeaux, 1878 - Paris, 1956) was a French Post-Impressionist painter, often described as a follower of Degas. A member of the Salon des Artistes Français (honourable mention 1901, third-class medal

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1911), he also exhibited at the Salon de la Société Nationale des Beaux-Arts and the Salon des Tuileries. A painter of Parisian life, theatre, circus and dance, he is especially sought after for his scenes of the Opera foyer.
