Oil on canvas signed "Gabriel Mathieu" lower right, by Gabriel Mathieu (1843-1921). The work depicts a riverbank landscape: still water fringed with reeds reflecting a wooded, autumn-toned hillside, while a path runs along the grassy bank beneath a silvery, hazy sky. A sensitive, atmospheric composition with fine muted light, characteristic of the artist's naturalism. Frame: 46 x 64 cm Artwork: 37 x 54 cm Gabriel Mathieu (1843-1921) was a French landscape painter associated with the Crozant School, the artists' colony that painted the Creuse valley in the wake of Armand Guillaumin. He mainly depicted the Creuse valley (Crozant, Gargilesse) and the banks of the Marne.
