A beautiful, gilded, carved wooden ciborium portal depicting a pelican (the Eucharistic symbol par excellence; in religious art, the pelican is often depicted standing above its nest, situated at the top of the cross, in the act of feeding its young; by "metaphor," it becomes an image of the Holy Spirit, evoking the heavenly purity of God.) Italian craftsmanship, late 18th century; the reverse features a cross embroidered on silk--dimensions: height 52 cm, width 32 cm, depth 4 cm
