Rectangular porcelain soup bowl by Samson in the style of the "Famille Rose" collection from the Compagnie des Indes. Rectangular base with a scalloped and undulating border, white glaze, embellished with a floral arrangement in a planter, a band decorated with a trellis pattern interrupted at the sides and corners by floral cartouches. A gold fillet outlines the rim. Produced by the Emile Samson workshop (1837-1913) famous for its reproductions of antique Asian porcelain. A red stamp on the reverse in the Chinese style. Dimensions: Height: 4.20 cm. Width: 22 cm. Length: 28.50 cm. Period: second half of the 19th century. No damage, cracks, or chips, just some wear on the gilding along the border.
