An extraordinary pair of French Empire-period candelabra, crafted in the early 19th century and signed by Thomire, one of the most celebrated bronze casters of the Napoleonic era. These works are of the highest artistic and historical value, intended for aristocratic and ceremonial use. The candelabra are crafted from finely chiseled bronze and gilded with mercury--a technique no longer in use--which imparts a warm, deep gilding of exceptional brilliance. The classic vase-shaped body rests on a quadrangular architectural base, richly decorated with ornamental motifs in the neoclassical style. The central body is embellished with allegorical figures in high relief, chiseled with great refinement and precision, while the upper section features elegantly curved arms that support the
