This 1940s butler's table, sometimes called a boat table, is made entirely of mahogany. It stands out for its elegant tabletop with folding edges; its four sections, connected by brass hinges, allow the surface to be adjusted for different uses, offering the choice of a perfectly flat surface or a protective rim inspired by marine furniture. The handles carved into each side emphasize its portable nature, reminiscent of tables used on boats where stability and ease of transport were essential. The tabletop rests on a foldable cross-shaped base, both sturdy and elegant, typical of British country furniture and widely adopted in ship cabins for its compact design. The mahogany, with its varied hues, lends the piece a noble and timeless presence, while the interplay of the wood's tones highlights artisanal

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craftsmanship where functionality blends with refined aesthetics. This iconic piece from the 1940s thus embodies the perfect balance between utility, elegance, and
