Description

This bent beech bench, stamped with the J&J Kohn mark, stands out for the natural elegance of its lines and the exceptional mastery of bent wood--a hallmark of Viennese craftsmanship since the late 19th century. Its beech frame, carefully shaped using steam, forms a harmonious silhouette in which each curve seems to flow with organic grace, from the delicately curved armrests to the backrest composed of three curved elements that create a perfectly balanced visual rhythm. The light and refined cane seat lends a warm, airy quality that subtly contrasts with the density of the wood, while the slender base, reinforced by a discreet crossbar, ensures elegant stability without ever weighing down the piece. The J&J Kohn stamp, a mark of authenticity and prestige, enshrines this piece in the history of

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bentwood furniture, alongside the most sought-after creations of the era. This bench, both functional and sculptural, blends naturally into a contemporary or classic interior, where it makes a statement with noble simplicity and timeless charm. The firm J. & J. Kohn, founded in Vienna in 1849, became one of the leading manufacturers of bent beech furniture thanks to innovative industrial production and major collaborations with designers of the Vienna Secession, before merging with Mundus and then Thonet, and finally ceasing operations in 1937 under pressure from the Nazi regime. J. & J.
