The armchairs feature an exposed chrome-plated tubular steel frame--characteristic of the model--supported by thick black leather cushions that offer remarkable comfort. The original back straps and the serial numbers engraved on the frame attest to their early production by the Italian manufacturer Cassina. This pair bears the engraved references LC3 007292 and LC3 007294, closely matching serial numbers that confirm they are a matching set. A vintage edition

likely produced in the late 1970s or early 1980s. In very good overall condition. The armchairs display a beautiful patina of use consistent with their age.
