



Two 19th-century Meissen Porcelain Figurines: A Woman With A Dog

Description

Two figures depicting two ladies, part of a series of genre scenes showing noblewomen engaged in various activities. The first, based on a 1776 model by Michel Victor Acier, depicts a woman in an 18th-century dress with a floral pattern, seated with a small dog on her lap that is looking at its reflection. 14.5 cm The second, wearing a Rococo dress with floral motifs and porcelain lace details. 13.5 cm 19th century. Based on a general inspection, they do not appear to have any damage, except for a restoration on the back of the headpiece and a small chip on the front of the figure with the dog, as well as a small chip on the base of the second figure--all visible in the photos; furthermore, since the decoration is made of lace, there may be slight imperfections even if they are not visible to the naked eye.
