This remarkable Art Deco-style pendant immediately captivates with its large aquamarine, perfectly balanced by the extreme delicacy of its design. Crafted in platinum and 375/°° white gold (9 KT), it elegantly exemplifies the refinement of designs inspired by the 1920s and 1930s. At the heart of the piece sits the large aquamarine, weighing approximately 33 carats and cut into a rectangular shape with beveled edges. Its delicate, very light blue color evokes the crystal-clear waters from which this gemstone derives its name. This subtle shade, particularly sought after in the finest aquamarines, is magnified by a crystal structure of great purity. The stone exhibits remarkable transparency as well as a beautiful luminosity that brings each of its facets to life, giving it a refined brilliance while

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retaining the softness that characterizes this gem. The bezel and bail, delicately set with 8/8-cut diamonds, are a testament to the high quality of the jewelry craftsmanship. The geometric motifs, fine engravings, beaded platinum, and openwork details faithfully reflect the key aesthetic codes of Art Deco, where the precision of the lines is combined with execution of extreme delicacy. The bail, far from being a mere functional element, plays a full part in the composition's aesthetic: its geometric design, perfectly integrated into the setting and delicately accented with diamonds, elegantly extends the lines of the pendant and attests to the care taken with every detail of its creation. Views from the side reveal a finely openwork gallery--a hallmark of the most meticulously crafted pieces--which visually lightens the setting while allowing light to pass through the stone, enhancing its brilliance. This design also ensures the pendant sits perfectly, resting naturally against the chest thanks to the balance of its setting. The piece as a whole is distinguished by its particularly harmonious design. Despite the impressive size of its aquamarine, the pendant retains a remarkable visual lightness thanks to the stone's transparency, the delicacy of the setting, and the perfect balance of its proportions. The setting never competes with the gem; it supports it with discretion and elegance, fully fulfilling its role as a showcase for light. The emerald cut, emblematic of aquamarine, plays a key role in the personality of this creation. Considered the preferred cut for this gemstone, it is traditionally chosen for the finest aquamarines, elegantly revealing their clarity, transparency, and crystalline quality. With its long, stepped facets, it does not seek excessive sparkle but rather highlights the depth, purity, and natural nobility of the crystal. This choice, particularly characteristic of fine jewelry creations, admirably highlights the quality of this stone and reinforces the piece's timeless character. The combination of this substantial aquamarine with such a delicate Art Deco setting gives rise to a piece of great
