Description

An elegant testament to Cartier's style of the 1980s and 1990s, this open bangle perfectly illustrates the House's ability to transform its graphic identity into a piece of jewelry that is instantly recognizable. Its design is built around the famous Double C motif, emblematic of Cartier, which elegantly adorns both ends of the bracelet while ensuring the balance of its composition. Crafted in 750/°° (18 KT, charançon hallmark) yellow, white, and rose gold, it creates a refined interplay of contrasts through a succession of six parallel bands, arranged in pairs in each of the three golds. Each band is deliberately separated by a slight gap, lending depth and visual lightness to the overall design, while the three shades of gold interact harmoniously and subtly capture the light. The

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design is masterfully structured by the two Double C motifs, a refined interpretation of one of Cartier's most iconic graphic elements. Far from being mere ornamentation, they play a genuine architectural role by visually uniting the six parallel bands, ensuring their cohesion while elegantly accentuating the ends of the bracelet. This particularly refined design gives the piece an instantly recognizable identity and reflects Cartier's meticulous attention to harmonizing aesthetics and construction. The perfect regularity of the six parallel bands, the uniformity of their spacing, and the precision with which the Double C motifs unite them are testament to the meticulous craftsmanship characteristic of Cartier's great creations. The open bangle naturally hugs the wrist and is exceptionally comfortable to wear. The visual fluidity created by the alternating three shades of gold gives the piece a bold presence while maintaining great elegance--a quality that explains the enduring success of this line. Starting in the 1980s, Cartier developed several collections inspired by its own aesthetic codes. The Double C line, directly derived from the House's famous monogram, is one of its most elegant expressions. This bracelet offers a understated and architectural interpretation, where the emblem is deliberately simplified to emphasize the purity of the lines and highlight the harmonious interplay of the three golds. Signed Cartier and weighing 36.18 grams, this bracelet is a testament to high-quality craftsmanship, faithful to the standards of the prestigious Parisian House. It comes with its original Cartier case. Through the purity of its lines, the ingenuity of its construction, the balance of its proportions, and the excellence of its craftsmanship, this bracelet elegantly embodies Cartier's expertise.
