The original design was created by Gio Ponti, and the cups were manufactured by Richard Ginori at the Doccia factory in Florence in the 1920s, Ponti served as the artistic director of this factory from 1923 to 1933, Mark on the back of the plates: -della pittura di Doccia come dalla collezione d'arte anni 30 periodo Gio Ponti Limited edition -from the Doccia painting collection from the 1930s, Gio Ponti period. Richard-Ginori, renamed Ginori 1735 as of 2020, is a company founded on October 11, 1896 as a result of the merger of the Richard Ceramics company, originally from Lombardy, with the Manifattura di Doccia of Marquis Carlo Ginori, founded in 1737 in the town of Doccia. Richard-Ginori, which was officially declared bankrupt in January 2013, was acquired in May 2013 by the Gucci Group. Giovanni Ponti, known as Gio (Milan, 1891 - Milan, 1979), is considered one of the masters of Italian architecture; he was also one of the most important designers and essayists of the 20th century.
