Description

Jean Bruller (also known as a writer under the
pseudonym Vercors). The work was printed in an
edition of 255 copies numbered in Arabic
numerals; our copy with the series is numbered in
Roman numerals, suggesting it was a gift copy or
a contributor's copy. Sent by the author. A very
fine copy. Jean Bruller, known as Vercors, born
in 1902 and died in 1991 in the 1st
arrondissement of Paris, was a French illustrator
and writer. He adopted the literary pseudonym
Vercors in 1941 during the Resistance.

Dealer

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Subsequently, he retained his surname for his work as an artist and his pen name as his writer's name. His most famous novel is *Le Silence de la mer* (*The Silence of the Sea*), published clandestinely in 1942.
