Description

Large globe with a diameter of 50 cm, inscribed "Globe with a diameter of 0.50 cm... by E. Dubail. Engraved by AL. Soldan. Printed by Monrocq" and, in a second cartouche, "J. Lebègue et Cie. Publishers and Manufacturers of Globes" The large 50-cm globe, with a polar mount, is mounted on a sturdy cast-iron tripod base featuring three mascarons. It is rare to find bases of this size. The globe measures approximately 90 cm in height by 50 cm in diameter. This globe is therefore one of the largest produced at the time. It is extremely rare. It has an old crack at the equator that has been restored; however, there are two facsimile pieces on the African continent. Nevertheless, it is a rare and particularly decorative globe.
