A refined panel of embroidered silk, made in Italy during the 18th century, featuring an elegant floral motif in the Baroque style. The composition is enlivened by sinuous plant tendrils, stylized flowers, and foliage embroidered with silk threads in delicate shades of ivory, beige, light blue, and blue, in a decorative style typical of 18th-century textile production intended for formal settings. The quality of the embroidery and the richness of the design make this piece a precious testament to 18th-century Italian textile art. Today, it is enhanced by a simple frame veneered in walnut, which highlights its elegance without altering its historical character. Its condition is consistent with its age: the fabric exhibits natural ripples and signs of aging, elements that attest to its
