Description

This oil painting on canvas depicts Vespasian, one of the eleven portraits of the Caesars painted by Tiziano Vecellio for Duke Federico II Gonzaga between 1538 and 1549--paintings that were destroyed in Madrid during a fire. Campi had copied the Caesars, using the drawings as models, and later, around 1580, he created one or perhaps more series of twelve paintings, adding Domitian. This portrait comes from a collection in Mantua.
