It features an elegant printed design enhanced by hand, consisting of a chinoiserie scene in a central medallion, framed by a rich polychrome floral border and gilded fillets. This refined decoration, highly prized during the Belle Époque, lends great charm to this decorative piece. The tray can be used as a trinket tray, an inkwell mat, or simply as a display piece.
