Standing before a heavy curtain, the figure strikes a theatrical pose that highlights the delicacy of her costume, consisting of a colorful headdress, a lace bodice, puffy pants, and an ornate sash. The delicate color palette and precise details reflect the Orientalist style that enjoyed great popularity in the late 19th century. The work is signed Saint-Marc Levier in the lower left corner.
