Sheraton sideboard designed by Giotto Stoppino and Lodovico Acerbis for Acerbis International, a 1977 design that won the Compasso d'Oro award in 1979. The piece is crafted from walnut wood in its most refined version and features a spacious top and four storage compartments concealed behind two doors. The piece stands out for its original opening system, which innovatively combines sliding doors and hinged doors--a technical and aesthetic solution that is one of the project's defining features. The Acerbis International brand is featured in three different ways: engraved on the hinges, via an adhesive label on the back panel, and with the Acerbis logo applied to the first drawer.
