Description

Albert Pierre BÉGAUD 1901-1996 French School Bathers with Black Swans Oil on canvas, 33 x 41 cm. without frame Good condition Pierre-Albert Bégaud was a French portraitist and landscape painter born in Bordeaux. He contributed large frescoes to the decoration of the Bordeaux Labor Exchange and the Maritime Exchange. He was part of that generation of Aquitaine artists from the interwar period sought after for their landscapes and portraits. He is particularly renowned for his depictions of the Basque Country, which consistently capture the Pyrenean countryside, its buildings, and its atmosphere with great sensitivity. A professor at the École des Beaux-Arts in Bordeaux, he enjoys a very high reputation in his hometown. In 2006, on the

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fiftieth anniversary of his death, the artist's family bequeathed a significant collection of drawings, and a book was published to mark the occasion, tracing the painter's career and life in *Le coeur et la raison*, published by Éditions du Festin
