ARTIST'S BIOGRAPHYÉdouard Van Esbroeck (April 27, 1869, Londerzeel, Flemish Brabant, Belgium - January 3, 1949, Leeuw-Saint-Pierre, Belgium) was a major Belgian painter of the late 19th and early 20th centuries. His work spans history painting, portraits, genre scenes, and religious subjects, with a predilection for luminous landscapes and intimate domestic scenes.Education and Career- Studied at the

Awards and honors:- 1892: Honorable mention in the Belgian Prix de Rome for *The Last Victims of the Flood*.- 1893: Second prize in painting at the Godecharle Competition for *Comforter of the Slaves*.- His scholarships enabled him to travel throughout Europe (Vienna, Munich, Berlin, Italy), where he studied the Italian Primitives.- Marriage: Married Jeanne Defooz in Brussels in 1899.
