Description

A beautiful oil on canvas mounted on board by the painter Georges Bergès (1870-1934), depicting the famous Pont d'Ascaïn, one of the most iconic sites in the Basque Country. Here, the artist offers a luminous and poetic interpretation of this landscape. The composition centers on the majestic arch of the bridge, delicately draped with wisteria in shades of pink, mauve, and blue, which contrasts harmoniously with the deep greens of the vegetation and the reflections on the river. In the background, traditional Basque houses and the contours of the mountains are visible, lending the scene a beautiful sense of depth. A painter renowned for his landscapes of southwestern France, Georges Bergès excels in his treatment of light and color, in a style that lies between Post-Impressionism and Regionalism.
