A beautiful cast bronze faucet consisting of two well-fitted parts, known as a "cannelle de foudre"; body with whimsical head, and handle with an ergonomic grip, features a conical socket that still works well. Entire assembly was driven into the wood of cask or barrel with a mallet, hence the upturned nose of this charming hunting dog. 23 cm x 14 cm x 10 cm, 1.550 kg, Côtes du Rhône, late 18th or early 19th century. Beautiful, untouched dark patina, good condition, BUT, a rather rustic old repair on base of handle, which explains its price.
