Front closure featuring an inner belt, drawstring, and hook-and-eye fastening. The waist is skillfully constructed with organ-pipe or cannon pleats, flaring out into a full-skirted skirt. The bodice is lined with blue-checked cotton household linen. Original piece with no flaws or later alterations. The Indian print has retained its original finish! No flaws.
