Hussar Officer's Saber - Consulate Period - 18th century
Brass mount, known as "German-style." Short pommel and single-branch guard with line-engraved decoration and a right angle formed by the quillon and reinforcement
Two diamond-shaped lugs
Checkered wooden grip with vertical lines
Curved blade with a hollow back, engraved one-third of the way down with a charging hussar, military and floral motifs
Flat-backed blade with a single cutting edge and a counter-edged tip
Plain brass scabbard with two bands and an iron pommel. Note: two slight dents near the tip
Length: 101 cm
SF lengths: : 98 cm
Blade length: 85 cm
Blade width at the heel: 3 cm
