Period: 1950s, 20th century
Description: Large and beautiful plum-colored blown glass vase, beautifully crafted. The base, blown separately, was joined to the body of the vase while hot using pliers--a technique characteristic of the craftsmanship of that era, leaving a discreet and typical seam. Small air bubbles are present within the glass, a hallmark of traditional glassblowing and a mark of authenticity for a piece from this period. Beautiful sculptural design, likely of Belgian or French origin, in the spirit of mid-20th-century artisanal glassworks.
