Set of four chairs attributed to André Sornay - Lyon - circa 1960A rare set of four chairs attributed to the Lyon-based designer and cabinetmaker André Sornay (1902-2000), a leading figure in postwar French modernist furniture. Crafted from solid pine, these chairs captivate with their deliberately understated and architectural design. Their construction highlights the straight lines, cubic forms, and joinery characteristic of Sornay's work, which was intended for both private interiors and public spaces. The band-style backrest and slatted seat offer a remarkable balance between formal simplicity and sturdiness, in a style that foreshadows the minimalist furniture of the 1960s. The four chairs are period pieces and feature a beautiful original patina. They retain
