This example is especially desirable as it retains its original black lacquer finish, an uncommon alternative to the standard engine-turned silver plated models. It also features an engraved white metal monogram plaque, almost certainly added for its original owner.

The mechanism bears the markings "PAT." and "PREFOR", identifying the early patented system fitted to these first-generation lighters.
