Description

Two major features stand out in this piece: its relatively narrow width (65 cm), which makes it suitable for placement in a hallway or entryway, and its rich, saturated earthy tones. It is these very hues, along with its texture, that allow us to date this piece to the late 19th century. Origin: Adiyaman in southeastern Anatolia. The weaving is a true marvel--precise, even, and delicate. Across the entire surface, there is a succession of woven and embroidered horizontal bands. The color palette is deep and pure. The saturated indigo blues are almost aquatic. In perfect condition! Circa 1880 Dimensions: 285 x 65 cm It is important to note that this piece is the work of Kurdish weavers. The colors reveal this, as does the weaving, which requires exceptional dexterity. Like a signature, it features very pretty
