19th-century French Naval Officer's dirk, Restoration period (circa 1830). Grip with mother-of-pearl scales. Gilt, chased brass mountings. Pommel featuring a scroll design adorned with wings and palm fronds. Guard with a chain and S-shaped quillons decorated with oak leaves and small floral motifs. Curved blade with a rounded spine, false edge, and fullers. Scabbard of brass chased with acanthus leaves and foliage, featuring two suspension rings. Circa 1830. Total length: 47 cm. Small crack in the mother-of-pearl on one scale. Provenance: Private French collection. Taxes and customs duties are included in the shipping costs for international shipments.
