The removable seat cushions are upholstered in a beautiful

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striped fabric in shades of red, coral, and gold.

This fabric complements the dark wood perfectly and adds a touch of warmth without detracting from the graceful lines of the frame. The upholstery is in very good condition and provides a comfortable seat for everyday use.

This cohesive set combines sturdiness and functionality while retaining the charm and authenticity characteristic of antique English furniture.
