A vibrant oil painting on cardboard measuring 27 cm x 21 cm, plus a gilded frame measuring 41 cm x 36 cm depicting a bouquet of flowers bursting with colors. Signed "JOVINE" in the lower left corner, dated 1961. Alphonse Jovine was born on April 3, 1930, in Marseille and died on July 24, 1989, in Marseille. He attended the Beaux-Arts from 1948 to 1950. It was difficult to support a family through painting alone. He practiced his art to make a living, working as a sign painter: posters, labels, and storefront signs. His free time was devoted to painting and reading comic books. He was a fan of American comic books. A Provençal painter with a naïve or faux-naïve style... His love of comics, the study of graphic design, and colors undoubtedly influenced his painting, particularly his characters. In the 1960s,

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he frequented the bar "Le Peano" on Cours d'Estienne d'Orves in Marseille, where he met a number of painters and artists with whom he formed close ties: Ambrogiani, Quilici, Cousinou, Toursky... During that time, he received the City of Marseille's first prize for painting. He held several exhibitions in Marseille at galleries such as "L'atelier" and "Le Lacydon" during the 1970s and 1980s.
