Description

Elegant Chinese teapot in glossy glaze porcelain, decorated on each side with a porcelain reserve decorated in blue enamels under cover and red iron, representing two characters in a stylized landscape. This type of production, characteristic of the Kangxi period. The body of the teapot is covered with a finely speckled olive brown glaze. Under this glaze appears, depending on the incidence of the light, a decoration engraved (incised) with rinceaux and floral motifs, executed before cooking. This work of great finesse, discreet but refined, is a quality detail that enriches the aesthetics of the piece and testifies to the care taken in its realization. The turned wooden lid is attached and integrates harmoniously into the whole. State: Cover attached. Some chips on the spout. Beautiful
